# Verses to Reflect On

God doesn't waste anything.



## God speaks in the smallest moments.

### These scriptures remind us to notice Him in the everyday:

📖 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

*Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.*

📖 Matthew 6:26

*Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?*

📖 Luke 21:1-4

*Jesus watched as a widow put two small coins into the offering. Though the amount was small, He saw the heart behind the gift.*

📖 Proverbs 16:9

*In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps.*

# How to Start Penny Jar Prayers

## 1. FIND A JAR

You don't need anything fancy—just a simple jar, mug, or bowl will do. But if you'd like to make it special, I've created a few Penny Jar Prayer labels for you! Think of them as little gifts to make this practice even more meaningful. You can print one out, cut it to size, and attach it to your jar as a reminder of what it represents.

As you create your jar, let it be a quiet moment with God—a chance to pause and invite Him into this simple but powerful practice. 🍷

## 2. LOOK FOR COINS & PRAY

Each time you find a penny—or any coin—pause and let it spark a prayer. Choose one of two simple ways to pray:

🍷 Look up – Pray for the first person you see. Whether you know them or not, lift them up to God.

🍷 Look at the year – Thank God for something significant from that time. It could be a personal memory, a lesson you learned, or someone who came into your life that year.

## 3. ADD THE COIN TO YOUR JAR

Drop the coin in, knowing that every moment of prayer is seen by God. Over time, your jar will become more than a collection of coins—it will be a tangible testimony of connection, gratitude, and faithfulness.

## 3. WHEN THE JAR IS FULL, GIVE IT AWAY

DroPrayer was never meant to be collected—it was meant to be given. When your jar is full, take a moment to ask God, Who can I bless with this? Maybe it's a single mom, a ministry, or a young person following a dream. Let your prayers become a blessing in someone else's life.

# Penny Jar Prayers Challenge

## **Day 1:**

Find a jar or container and set it in a visible place. Say a short prayer, inviting God to use this practice to deepen your awareness of Him.

## **Day 2:**

If you don't find a coin today, take one from your wallet, purse, or a coin jar at home. Hold it in your hand and pray for the first person who comes to mind.

## **Day 3:**

Choose any coin you already have. Look at the year and thank God for something significant from that time—a person, a lesson, or a moment of His faithfulness.

## **Day 4:**

Take a few minutes to decorate or label your jar as a reminder of its purpose. Let this be a time of reflection and prayer.

## **Day 5:**

Pay attention today. Look for “God’s winks”—small reminders of His presence, even if they aren’t coins. A kind word, a moment of peace, a song at the right time. Thank Him for what you notice.

## **Day 6:**

Ask God to bring someone to mind who needs prayer today. Even if you don't find a coin, pause and pray for them, lifting up their needs with love and faith.

## **Day 7:**

Sit with your jar. Reflect on how this practice has helped you notice God in the small things. Ask Him to continue leading you in moments of prayer throughout your day.
